CamperLink is your virtual backstage pass to the fun and excitement of summer camp. View action photos from camp daily all summer long! One way email will also be offered directly from our website at no cost. Only messages sent from this online form will be delivered to campers. Campers will receive a printed copy of the message, but they will not be able to reply via email.

CamperLink is a password protected service of Marmon Valley Farm designed to enable you to view photos of campers busy playing, learning, smiling and growing. While photos are updated almost daily, we cannot guarantee all campers will be photographed. We will attempt to maintain a good variety of quality photos each day that represent a cross section of the excitement of camp. The photo galleries are hosted by ephotoservices.com, who also make it possible to purchase photos online if you wish to do so. Should you need technical assistance, the galleries and the photo printing services are supported by the support team at ephotoservice.com. Basic usage questions or password issues with CamperLink can be reported to us at support@marmonvalley.com. We will attempt to resolve as issues as soon as possible. We cannot provide support for unrelated computer problems.

Getting Started:

1. Go to www.marmonvalley.com on any web browser.
2. Click the "CamperLink" button located on the bottom of the screen.
3. Complete the Registration Form and click the "Submit" button. In the field marked User Name enter the following value in lowercase letters with no spaces:
4. Once the form has been successfully submitted, you will receive your password immediately.
5. Now click the Login in button and enter your username and password. This will take you directly into CamperLink. From here you go right to the photo gallery or you can read over the basic instructions for usage. Happy browsing!



After you register, you will be able to visit our online community all year long!! You do not need to register again. If other friends or family members would like to log in, you may share this *username* with them, so they can register, too (steps 1-5). Please keep in mind only those who have been given this information will be able to access this site. We password protect our CamperLink photo gallery to protect our camp community and to comply with the Children's Online Safety Protection Act. Remember CamperLink will not have any new pictures posted until the start of camp in June. Pictures from the previous summer remain available online, too.

Medication

For everyone's safety, all medications must be turned in at the Nurse Station during registration. Please ensure that you have sufficient medication for your child's stay. Medications should be in the actual prescription container not a daily pill box. Most pharmacists will provide a smaller size bottle for camp if necessary. We reserve the right to turn away campers who arrive with communicable illnesses (lice, pink eye, strep throat, etc.) All camper have a quick wellness screening during registration.

Lost and Found

Marmon Valley Farm is not responsible for lost items. Please contact the office as soon as possible about lost items. Lost and found clothing and accessories will be given to charity following the summer.
